On 19th August 2011, Hadrat Khalīfatul Masīh V ايدهاللتعالى delivered the Friday Sermon at Baitul Futūh Mosque, London.

Hudur اليه said: The Promised Messiah عليه has stressed the importance and necessity of prayers and has shown us how we can become God's true servants in the light of the verse إيك نعبد و اياك نعبد و اياك نستعين [Thee alone do we worship and Thee alone do we implore for help]. The Promised Messiah عليه says that prayer sets right all one's affairs, whether of this world or the next. He says that prayer is an act that saves us from evil conduct; it purifies us and leads us to God.

Hudur اليواشَّاتُا said: Without the help of God, it is not possible to perform worship that is acceptable to Him and also bears positive results. Worship is the purpose of man's creation and the prayer اياك نعبد و اياك نستعين , which we recite in our obligatory prayers and *nawafil*, shows us the way to achieve this purpose.

Hudur اليره الله تعالى said: The use of the plural in this prayer signifies that one should not only pray for oneself, but also for one's family, one's kin, one's community and mankind at large. This prayer also underlines the importance of effort. Just as a farmer tills the ground and sows the seed, so should a believer make every effort in his power to achieve his objective, along with prayers.

Hudur اليوالله said: Salat is the chief of all worship. It is a conveyance that leads directly to God. We should offer our prayers regularly and try to find pleasure in our worship as the Promised Messiah ما المعالم has taught us. May Allāh enable us to make the best use of these teachings so that we may become His true

servants. Hudur ايدهالله urged Ahmadīs to concentrate on their prayers particularly in these last days of Ramadān.
