On 16th September 2011, Hadrat Khalīfatul Masīh V ايداللدتعال delivered the Friday Sermon from Germany.

Hudur ايد الله prayed for the success of the various Ijtimā's that are being held in Germany, UK and other countries. Hudur ايد الله said: As the Jama'at continues to progress with each passing day, more and more people try to create mischief and hurdles in our path. We must remember however that this opposition is a yardstick that signifies our success.

The Promised Messiah عليه السلام says:

"Do not pay any heed to the opponents, for if you continue to progress in virtue and piety, Allāh will be with you. He has conveyed to me that people are entering this Jama'at in great numbers. This is because Allāh has invested this Jama'at with a special attraction that draws people towards it."

Hudur ايرواللاتعال said: As a sign of the truth of the Promised Messiah ايرواللاتعال this attraction is being experienced even today. Allāh is drawing people towards the Promised Messiah عيراللام through extraordinary means. In spite of all the opposition, Allāh's blessings upon the Jama'at are multiplying.

Hudur العراشتىان said: People of this world cannot destroy Divine Jama'ats. We have seen powerful opponents perishing in failure and frustration. We have seen many mischief makers who became the victims of their own cunning. And all along, this Divine Jama'at is getting closer and closer to its goal. Hudur الدواللت ited several instances of how people living in different parts of the world have been guided to Ahmadiyyat through MTA.

Hudur العواشقان said: Truthfulness is the hallmark of an Ahmadī, which he must never let go off. The Sharī'ah lays down two fundamental duties: our obligations to God and our obligations to mankind. The obligations to God consist in worshipping and obeying Him and not associating any partners with His person or His attributes. And our responsibilities to our fellow beings consist in shunning arrogance, pride, dishonesty and wrongful behaviour. We must do our best not to think ill of our brothers. Instead we should cultivate trust and good-will which leads to mutual love. We are also taught to fulfil our obligations to our neighbours and to correct our behaviour in every way so as to be truly deserving to be member of the Jama'at of the Promised Messiah $r^{\mu\nu}$.

The Promised Messiah مليالسلام says:

"The purpose of my coming is that the believers should adopt piety and purity and worship the One God."

He says:

"Remember, if this mission of mine is a worldly endeavour, it will vanish without a trace; but if it is from God, it will be safeguarded by angels and continue to grow even if the whole world stands up against it."
