On 25<sup>th</sup> November, 2011, Hadrat Khalīfatul Masīh V ايدهالله تقالى delivered the Friday Sermon at Baitul Futūh Mosque, London.

Hudur ايدوالله said: I was recently invited to attend a function held by the Ahmadiyya Pan-African Association celebrating the Golden Jubilee of the independence of several African countries. Many of these countries have lived for a long time under foreign rule as virtual slaves. This is why holding these independence celebrations are so important for them.

Hudur ايده الله said: Allāh sends His Prophets into the world also to free and deliver mankind, but many nations have failed to understand this and have suffered Divine retribution.

Hudur ايدهالله said: The greatest example before us is that of the Holy Prophet صلى الله عليه وَمَالُم who, even today, liberates everyone who follows him.

Quoting verses from the Holy Qur'ān and Ahādīth in which kindness to slaves is stressed and the merit of freeing them is highlighted, Hudur على الله said: Islām wants to gradually end all slavery. If we learn from the kindness which the Holy Prophet من الله عليه والله and his Companion من الله عليه على الله عليه على الله عليه على الله على so the slaves, we will be able to pave the way for a free society that is just and kind. African Ahmadīs should spread these teachings and bring their people to the fold of the Holy Prophet من الله عليه والله على so that they may taste true and everlasting freedom.

Hudur اليووالشرة said: The reason for the uprisings in many countries is that the rulers try to subjugate their people and usurp their rights. Ultimately people rise against them and take the law into their own hands; the whole system is thus turned upside down and no one is safe. If these governments had abided by the norms of justice and had provided freedom and justice to their people, things would not have come to such a crisis.

Hudur ايده الله said: The so-called *ulama* of today have bound their people in the shackles of un-Islamic traditions and innovations, whereas the Holy Prophet صلى الله على came to free us of all such burdens. Thus both the worldly and religious authorities have enslaved their subjects.

Hudur ايده الله said: The Promised Messiah ايده الله تعالى was ordained to free us from all shackles. He taught us only to be the slaves of the Holy Prophet ملى , so that we may be lead to freedom, justice and equality and to the creation of a society where people do not have to resort to violence and

demonstrations; instead everyone, whether he be king or pauper, strives to give others their rights. Addressing the people in power, Hudur عيه الله said: If they continue to subjugate their people, do not give them their rights and do not abide by justice, they will come under Divine chastisement and will be answerable for the plight of their people.

Referring to the discrimination and persecution which Pakistani Ahmadīs are suffering on account of their love and fidelity to the Holy Prophet  $|u_{ij}|^{2}$ , Hudur  $|u_{ij}|^{2}$  said: We have preferred enslavement that comes from our loyalty to God and the Holy Prophet oworldly freedom. May Allāh grant us strength and steadfastness in times of trial.  $\bar{A}m\bar{i}n$ .
