On 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2012, Hadrat Khalīfatul Masīh V ايوالله delivered the Friday Sermon at Bai'atul Futūh Mosque, London.

Hudur اليواللي quoted from Register *Rawayat* (the register containing the narratives of the Companions of the Promised Messiah (علياليا) some extracts that cast light on the bravery and fortitude shown by the Companions after they accepted Ahmadiyyat; and also how they deliberated deeply about Islām and Holy Qur'ān and acted upon its teachings, and having once recognized and accepted the truth bore every hardship for its sake.

Hudur العالي said: Having believed and pledged Bai'at to the Promised Messiah العالي (بالمال), the companions vied with one another in doing good deeds. They testified to the truth of the Promised Messiah العالي through their conduct and affirmed his truth through their word and action. They were a brave people who were undeterred by opposition. They faced severe persecution and hardship but remained firm in their faith. Hudur said: Even students who accepted the Promised Messiah العاد ألف faced great hardship. Today also we see Ahmadī students suffering persecution, opposition and discrimination. But despite all this, our youth are only growing strong in their faith. May Allāh further strengthen their faith.

Hudur ايدواللدتعالى related the faith-inspiring accounts of the following Companions: Hadrat Mian Abdul Aziz Sahib, also known as Mughal Sahib; Hadrat Munshi Qazi Mahboob Alam Sahib; Hadrat Mehr Ghulam Hasan Sahib; Hadrat Khalīfa Nuruddin Sahib of Jammu; Hadrat Hakim Abdus Samad Khan Sahib, son of Hakim Abdul Ghani Sahib, of Delhi; and Hadrat Hafiz Ghulam Rasul Sahib of Wazirabad.

In conclusion, Hudur العرواللذتيالي said: Despite facing every form of persecution, Ahmadiyyat is growing from strength to strength and will continue to do so, *inshallah*. Ahmadīs everywhere in the world are becoming more courageous in expressing their faith. Having believed, they bear in mind the Divine injunction, "Fear not them, but fear Me." May Allāh enable Ahmadīs to remain steadfast and to grow stronger in the affirmation of their faith.  $\bar{A}m\bar{n}n$ .
