The Amīr/National President Jamā'at Ahmadiyya,

Dear Brother,

On 4th May 2012, Hadrat Khalīfatul Masīh V ليواللدتعالى delivered the Friday Sermon at Baitul Futūh, London.

Hudūr ^{رض}ى الله عنه</sup> quoted some accounts related by the Companions الدوالله تعالى of the Promised Messiah مايي السلام which show their zeal, passion and love for the Promised Messiah مايي السلام and how eager they were to visit Qādiān and see the Promised Messiah مايي السلام.

Hudūr ايدەاللدتعالى said: Mian Muhammad Zahuruddin Sahib relates, once we reached in the presence of the Promised Messiah ^{الميرالرا} in Qādiān we would forget all the rest. We would never like to be separated from him. It was nothing but sheer Divine grace that He caused worthless people like us to be born in this blessed age and then led us to his blessed presence. Hadrat Haji Muhammad Musa Sahib would regularly travel from Lahore to Qādiān to offer Jumu'a prayer. He would cover twenty-two miles from Batala to Qādiān and back on bicycle. Hadrat Mian Zahuruddin Sahib says: When the Promised Messiah مليدالسار arrived in Masjid Mubarak it seemed as if the sun had risen to its zenith. By God, his beauty was far greater than I had anticipated. I was completely satisfied after beholding his enlightened countenance. All other beautiful faces paled in comparison to his. Hadrat Sheikh Abdul Karim Sahib relates: Once the Promised Messiah ^{algebraid} said: people think that since they have seen the Promised Messiah ^{Juliul} and pledged allegiance of Bai'at to him, it is enough for them to be forgiven, whereas it is the prayer "Thee alone do we worship and Thee alone do we implore for help" that can guarantee the ultimate success. I have only come to show the path and so have I done.

Hadrat Dr. Umar Din Sahib says: I was so eager to shake hands with the Promised Messiah ${}^{\mu_{u}|\nu_{u}}$ that I would often elbow my way through the jostling crowd to reach him, yet my desire would always remain unsatiated. It is reported about Hadrat Dr. Abdullah Sahib that he used to save money so that he could make frequent visits to Qādiān to benefit from the blessed company of the Promised Messiah ${}^{\mu_{u}|\nu_{u}|}$. Hadrat Mian Charagh Din Sahib relates: When I saw the Promised Messiah ${}^{\mu_{u}|\nu_{u}|}$ I became convinced that this can never be the countenance of a liar, so I immediately took Bai'at. Hadrat Munshi Qādi Mahboob Alam Sahib set out to Qādiān on account of a blessed vision. He says: My first meeting with the Promised Messiah ${}^{\mu_{u}|\nu_{u}|}$ took place just in front of the door of *Gol Kamra*. The moment I saw the Promised Messiah had seen in the dream and that he was true in his claim. I embraced him, started crying uncontrollably and could not stop for quite some time. In the end, Hudūr الدواللدتعالى said: These are the accounts of those who were ever eager to meet and see the Promised Messiah عليه الساري. They faced hardships in this cause, but these hardships looked so small in comparison to the great benefits they derived from the Promised Messiah عليه الساري, and his blessed company always increased them in their faith.
