The Amīr/National President Jamā'at Ahmadiyya,

On 1st March 2013, Hadrat Khalifatul Masih V ايدهالله الله delivered the Friday Sermon at Baitul Futuh Mosque, London.

After reciting verse 22 of surah Al-Ra'd, which is translated as follows:

"And those who join what Allah has commanded to be joined, and fear their Lord, and dread the evil reckoning." (13:22)

Budur اليوالشتان said: In this verse Allāh has enjoined the strengthening and fostering of mutual relations. A true believer, who possesses a believer's insight, can never think of doing anything contrary to the will of God. When he has once established a relationship, he never goes back on it. A believer obeys God perfectly and, having loved Him completely, turns to His creatures in keeping with His commandments and fosters relationships of kinship, brotherhood and kindness.

Hudur اليوه الشرقالي said: Believers are those who fear God. Fear in this sense is the fear of losing something after having recognized its great beauty and value. In other words, it is not the fear of injury, rather it is based on the certainty that something is of the highest value. For a believer, God is the greatest of all and he never wishes to lose Him. Even those of little faith never wish to sever their link with God.

Hudur اليوه الشقاق said: When a person truly fears God in this sense, he then turns to God's creatures, fulfils his obligations towards them and tries to establish and sustain relationships. It is a pity, however, that when we look at people's conduct, it is far from exemplary. They read the Holy Qur'ān, read the translation, fear God and do not wish to be rejected by Him, and yet they do not fulfil their obligations to their fellow beings. This is a clear contradiction. All Ahmadīs should examine themselves in this regard.

Hudur اليوه الشرتالي said: The Holy Qur'ān teaches believers to treat one another with the utmost love and kindness. But this is not what we see since worldly interests have taken precedence over the will of God. Hudur وعده ومعسها gave examples of several countries where, instead of fulfilling these obligations, people's rights are being usurped. The Holy Qur'ān declares believers to be brothers to one another, and also commands that if there is a dispute among them it should be settled. Fear God and partake of His attribute of kindness. A great reward is promised to those who do righteous deeds.

Hudur ايدهاللتعالى said: The Holy Qur'ān encourages brotherhood, peace, fostering of mutual relationships and forgiveness. This is the message which the Holy

Prophet صلى الشعلية والمسلم gave in his last Hajj sermon. He said: Your lives, you property, your honour is as sanctified as this day, this month and this place.

Hudur العوالة cited some Ahādīth which are briefly as follows: Whoever desires increase in wealth and a long life and wishes to be remembered after death should have good relationship with their relatives. Have mercy on those beneath you and respect your superiors. All people are God's children, so treat them with kindness. God is kind to those who are kind to others. Three things save a person from fire, (i) kindness, (ii) loving one's parents, (iii) being kind to one's servants. Fire has been forbidden upon those who are close to the people, i.e. who don't hate others. Allāh honours him who forgives; to forgive is not a disgrace. Whoever loves others for the sake of God will find God's shelter on the day where there will be no other shelter.

Hudur اليه الله الله exhorted the office-bearers of the Jama'at to show kindness to their subordinates, to adopt higher morals and to treat others with mercy and compassion. May Allāh grant us true understanding of love and kindness and enable us to follow His commandments. $\bar{A}m\bar{\imath}n$.

At the end of the sermon, Hudur اليه الله informed the Jama'at of the sad demise of an African-American Ahmadī Nāsira Saleema Raza Sahiba who lived in Zion (USA) and led her funeral prayer in absentia after the Jumu'a prayers.
